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Director's Corner

IN THE MIDDLE OF FEBRUARY, HILLSGROVE CLUBHOUSE HAD 140 ACTIVE MEMBERS. THIS IS A BIG ACHIEVEMENT FOR A FEW REASONS, AND MARKED THE FIRST TIME SINCE MARCH 2020 THAT WE HAVE OVER 138 ACTIVE MEMBERS AT THE TIME OUR LARGEST AMOUNT OF ACTIVE MEMBERS IN NEARLY A DECADE. WE SAW A STEADY DECLINE IN ACTIVE MEMBERS AFTER THE START OF COVID PROTOCOLS, DROPPING TO 110 ACTIVE MEMBERS THE WINTER OF 2021. OUR ABILITY TO FULLY RECOVER AND EVEN SURPASS OUR TOTAL IS THE RESULT OF HARD WORK AND THE QUALITY OF THE CLUBHOUSE EXPERIENCE. AS OUR WINTER WINDS DOWN, IT WILL BE THE FIRST TIME THAT OUR TOTAL MEMBERSHIP HAS GROWN DURING JANUARY AND FEBRUARY.

THIS IS OUR FIRST YEAR WITH OUR MEMBERSHIP TEAM, A GROUP OF MEMBERS AND STAFF DEDICATED TO OVERSEEING THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS OF NEW MEMBERS. THE SUCCESS OF THIS TEAM HAS OPENED NEW REFERRAL SOURCES AND STRENGTHENED OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH ALL OF OUR COMMUNITY PARTNERS. NEW MEMBER FEEDBACK CONFIRMS THAT OUR TOURS, ORIENTATION, AND ONGOING OUTREACH FOR NEW MEMBERS HAS MADE THE EXPERIENCE VERY POSITIVE AND ENGAGING. IN ADDITION, OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES HAS RESULTED IN US RECEIVING ALMOST TWICE AS MANY REFERRALS IN DECEMBER, JANUARY, AND FEBRUARY AS LAST YEAR. OUR EFFORT TO RAISE COMMUNITY AWARENESS OF THE CLUBHOUSE MATCHED WITH OUR GREAT SUPPORT FOR NEW MEMBERS IS A GREAT COMBINATION.

AT OUR FIRST HILLSGROVE CLUBHOUSE PLANNING DAY IN 2017, WE SET AN AMBITIOUS GOAL TO REACH 150 ACTIVE MEMBERS; AT THAT TIME, WE HAD 101 MEMBERS. BASED ON OUR CURRENT MEMBERSHIP AND HOW THE CLUBHOUSE TRADITIONALLY HAS ITS LARGEST ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP IN THE LATE SPRING, THIS AMBITIOUS GOAL SEEMS MORE THAN ACHIEVABLE. THE ENERGY AND EXCITEMENT OF A LARGE CLUBHOUSE IS ALREADY BEING FELT HERE ON MOST DAYS, AND IT WILL BE A THRILL TO SEE US REACH OUR FULL POTENTIAL. COME BY ANYTIME TO CHECK IT OUT.
