DIRECTOR'S CORNER

ONE OF THE FOUR RIGHTS OF MEMBERSHIP, WHICH IS ALSO ONE OF THE 36 STANDARDS FOR CLUBHOUSE PROGRAMS, IS THE RIGHT TO RETURN. ANY MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING THAT BECOMES INACTIVE CAN IMMEDIATELY RETURN AFTER ANY LENGTH OF ABSENCE. THIS MEANS THAT EVERY DAY, WE MAY SEE A MEMBER WALK INTO THE CLUBHOUSE THAT WE HAVEN'T SEEN FOR A FEW MONTHS OR EVEN A FEW YEARS. IT IS COMMON TO HAVE A COMMOTION AT OUR FRONT DESK WHEN WE SEE A MEMBER RETURN TO THE CLUBHOUSE.

WE KNOW THAT HAVING AN OPEN DOOR FOR MEMBERS TO RETURN IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF BUILDING COMMUNITY. IT ENCOURAGES PEOPLE TO TAKE THAT BIG LEAP INTO THEIR NEW JOB, SCHOOL, OR OTHER ENDEAVOR WITHOUT FEAR OF LOSING THE SUPPORT OF THE CLUBHOUSE. MEMBERS CAN CONTINUE IN THEIR MENTAL HEALTH RECOVERY JOURNEY AND KEEP IN TOUCH, MAYBE FOLLOW US ON FACEBOOK, READ OUR ONLINE NEWSLETTER, OR GIVE US A PHONE CALL TO CHECK IN AS WAYS TO STAY CONNECTED WHILE BEING INACTIVE. THERE ARE MANY REASONS A MEMBER MAY RETURN AFTER A LONG ABSENCE. OFTEN, IT IS TO JUST RECONNECT WITH FRIENDS AND CHECK OUT WHAT IS HAPPENING AT THE CLUBHOUSE. SOMETIMES IT IS TO GET SUPPORT FOR WORK OR SCHOOL, IT CAN ALSO BE TO RESTART THEIR OWN MENTAL HEALTH RECOVERY. REGARDLESS OF THE REASON, THE CLUBHOUSE REMAINS READY AND EAGER TO WELCOME PEOPLE BACK AND THERE IS ALWAYS PLENTY THAT NEEDS TO BE DONE.

IT IS VERY COMMON FOR US TO SEE RETURNING MEMBERS THROUGHOUT THE AUTUMN MONTHS. I THINK WE ARE ALL CONDITIONED TO RETURN TO SOMETHING AS THE WEATHER BEGINS TO CHANGE. WE ALSO SERVE GREAT PUMPKIN SPICED COFFEE DRINKS. THIS YEAR IT STARTED EARLY, WITH MANY RETURNING MEMBERS IN AUGUST. WE ANTICIPATE SEEING MANY MORE AS WE GEAR UP FOR SOME OF OUR FAVORITE EVENTS OF THE YEAR, INCLUDING OUR HILLSGROVE CLUBHOUSE COMPANY PICNIC SEPTEMBER 8TH AND OUR HARVEST DINNER NOVEMBER 16TH. 
